In the emerald waters of the Ionian, at the south-western end of Greece lies Zakynthos, land of poets, artists, music and song

Homer calls Zakynthosas «Yliessa», Plinius «Ylidi» and Virgil «Nemorosa», names associated with the idyllic beauty of the island, its dense forests and verdant nature. Zakynthos can offer an enchanting travel in time for culture lovers, since the island experienced both the Renaissance and the Enlightenment.

The island has been inhabited since the Palaeolithic Age and, due to its prominent geographical location, acted as a crossroads of East and West and attracted the ancient Greeks and Romans, the Byzantines, the counts of the Kingdom of Naples, the Venetians, the French and the English.



Today Zakynthos is an ideal destination. It boasts direct flights to and from the greatest European cities and ferry links to and from the Peloponnese, Kefalonia and Italy.


Its wonderfully warm climate has drawn the loggerhead sea turtle (Caretta caretta) to the beaches of Zakynthos, where it lays its eggs in the golden sand of some of the most beautiful beaches of the Mediterranean.

Winters are mild, with high temperatures and great sunshine.

The long summer of Zakynthos lasts from May to the end of October.

#### From the Castle to the Shore

The first tour in the city starts from high up in the Hill of the Castle [Castrolofos] and the **Fortress**, which towers over it, as its silent witness and guardian.

Walk to the **Venetian Castle**, a true monument of the history of the land, with a magnificent view in every direction.

Just below the Castle, lies **the Hill of Strani**. Here, under the trees, amid the fragrances of the countryside and listening to the sound of the cannons of Mesolongi, **Dionysios Solomos** wrote the «Hymn to Liberty» [the national anthem of Greece], in May 1823.

On the way from Bochali to the city lies the **Chapel of Agios Georgios of Filikon**, where **Theodoros Kolokotronis** took an oath as member of the Filiki Eteria. Next to it, lies the **Jewish Cemetery.**

One of the most significant sights of the city Wander off to Alexadrou Roma Street, the main financial and social street of the city, which is Agios Markos square, a historical and

cultural centre of the island, as it is where the Zakyntians burned the record of the nobles, the famous Libro d' Oro.

Visit the Museum of Solomos and Eminent People of Zakynthos, where Dionysios Solomos and Andreas Kalvos rest, as well as the Agios Markos Catholic Church. Behind the Cathedral, take a moment to admire the Church of Our Lady of Angels.



A pedestrian walkway links Agios Markos square to **Solomos square**, dominated by the statue of our Poet Laureate.

The square is adorned by the Museum of Zakynthos, where great works of Ionian art, rare icons and woodworks are on display, the **Cultural Centre**, located where the theatre used to be before the earthquake and accommodating the Public Library, the Historical Records and the Museum of National Re**sistance**, while next to it lies the picturesque church of Agios Nikolas of the Quay.

### Noon coolness

You can also board a glass-bottom boat, to admire the seabed of the island and the sea turtles in their natural habitat.

Then you can unwind, enjoying your meal, in one of the local tavernas, while, if you love water sports, you can have fun with beach volley, a game of rackets or pedaloes and canoes.

#### Afternoon in Bochali.



## From Argasi to Vasiliko

**Argasi** is the tourist resort closest to the city, with sandy, safe beaches and many tourist services.

In Argasi, the "Vrisakia", was the city's main source of water supply during the Venetian rule.

**The tower of Domenegini** hosted many of the meetings of the **Filiki Eteria** members of the island. Young **Ugos Foskolos** took shelter here, when persecuted by the authorities after defending the Jews of Zakynthos.

At the south of the island lies **Skopos**. In ancient times, it hosted the **shrine of Artemis**, while in its place there now stands the monastery of **Panagia Skopiotissa**.

The area of **Vasiliko** boasts some of the most beautiful beaches on the island and the most significant habitats of the loggerhead sea turtle [Caretta caretta], such as **Sekania** and **Dafne**, where the **Turtle Museum** is located.

The most beautiful beaches, with fabulous beach bars, on this side of the island are: Kaminia, Porto Zoro, Porto Azzuro, Ionio, Banana, Plaka, Agios Nikolaos, Mavratzis, Porto Roma and Gerakas.

If you enjoy **water sports**, have fun with water ski, Jet Ski, windsurfing, pedaloes and parasailing.

#### A relaxed ride

An afternoon tour of the city, the "chora" of Zakynthos, by carriage will allow you to see its most significant sites:

The **church of Faneromeni**, one of the most significant churches of Zakynthos, a monument of art and culture, the "**Xenopoulio" Museum**, the church of the Patron saint of Zakynthos **Agios Dionysios**, with its lovely steeple piercing the sky, the **Ecclesiastic Museum**, located just next to

the new wing of the **Holy Monastery of Agios Dionysios and Strofades**. Look for the small elegant religious souvenirs on sale here.

Try a local medieval snack, the fitura, which along with the pasteli [sesame bar], are the main sweet treats of the fairs on the island. Sense the special aroma of the "Flower of Levante" in one of the unique jasmine varieties, grantuka or bugarini.

## From Lagana to Keri

The beach of **Lagana** is the longest beach on the island, with shallow, warm, calm waters and golden sand, while it is also a habitat for the loggerhead sea turtle **[Caretta caretta]** and protected by the **National Marine Park.** 

Children can play safely in the calm waters and enjoy games on the beach.

From here, you can board on a glassbottom boat to see the sea turtles in their natural habitat.

If you like underwater explorations, you can experience the magic of the sea bottom by visiting one of the diving centres.

At the end of this lovely beach, near **Lithakia**, lies a column dedicated to the father of anatomy **Andreas Vesalius**.

The picturesque island of **Agios Sostis** was originally connected to land, but was later separated after the earthquakes of the 17th century.

One of the nicest sights of Lagana is the Sarakina, the ruins of a stately mansion, a typical example of the architecture of Zakynthos.

Lithakia with its beautiful beaches is one of the most picturesque villages of Zakynthos, still hosting many significant buildings of the ecclesiastic art of the island, such as the Churches of Agios Ioannis Theologos and of **Panagia Faneromeni**.



# Indulgence & rest

Just across lies Marathonisi, which you can visit with the special boats departing from here, or you can choose to go to the beach of Marathias and Pyrgakia or Mikres Mizithres.

A few kilometres from the cosmopolitan buzz of Lagana, **Keri** offers a calm and peaceful alternative, a perfect image of a heavenly option.

There are many things to choose from fine sand, pebbles, rocks, touring, snorkelling, caves and fresh fish.

The lake of Keri is known since antiquity as "Nafthi" or "Piges tis Pissas", and it was visited by **Herodotus**.







Near Keri lies Agalas, a village that has preserved its natural environment with traditional houses, pathways and lush nature. Visit the church of Our Lady of Angels, admire the Cave of Damianos and the Twelve Wells of Antronios.

In the afternoon, take a walk uphill to the Lighthouse of Keri situated on the cliff. From the top, one can see Mizithres and a magnificent sunset!











#### From the sea to the mountains

One of the most beautiful villages of Zakynthos is **Macherado**.

Admire the church of **Agia Mavra**, with its magnificent carved steeple, the chapel of **Ypapanti** and, going uphill on the way to Kiliomenos, make a stop at the **Monastery of Panagia Eleftherotria.** 

At **Kiliomenos**, visit the church of **Agios Nikolaos**, with its amazing stone steeple and the Monastery of **Panagia Yperagathou**.

Buy local products, homemade bread, local ladotyri [cheese], sweetened fruits in syrup and rusks from the Women's Association of the village **"E Melissiotisses"**.







# On the mountain overseeing the Ionian

Try a snack of fresh homemade bread with tomatoes, olives, local virgin olive oil, local ladotiri and oregano.

Visit **Agios Leontas**, with its beautiful church of **Agia Paraskevi** and continue to **Exo Chora**, to see the great plane on the square and the perennial olive tree of the village.

Cool off on the steep beaches of the area, such as **Korakonisi**, **Roxa**, **Limnionas**, **Stenitis** and **Porto Vromi**, combining a rugged landscape with crystal aquamarine waters.

Try the fruits of the sea! Fresh fish, fished right here, and tasty delicacies, pickled or grilled octopus, squid, shellfish and anything you can think of.







## Traditional villages

At Kabi, visit the local Mycenaean cemetery. Experience an unforgettable sunset, in a wild yet friendly, enchanting and imposing scenery.










# Good wine




# Sea journey...

The magnificent image of the coastline of Zakynthos offers a unique journey. There is a daily **island cruise** by day cruise ships. Don't forget your camera.


If you choose the extended cruise of Zakynthos, you will be impressed by the **north** and **west shores** of the island, with their wild and imposing beauty.

During your journey, you will discover impressive landscapes and sceneries forged when Nature was inspired. **Sea caves**, shaped by the waves over the centuries, such as the **Blue Caves**, special beaches, like the **Shipwreck [Navagio]**, **small islands** and **bays**, as well as **secret beaches**, under wild rocks, will take your breath away.









#### Road trips

You can choose to tour the island by bus, through travelling agencies, while for single trips you can use the internal bus lines of Zakynthos.

#### The routes

Travelling agencies have various routes; however, the main ones are:

**1st Route:** <u>Bochali</u> (stop for pictures), visit to a local winery. <u>Exochora</u> (brief stop for coffee). <u>Monastery of Anafonitria</u> Platform with a view to <u>"Navagio" Volimes</u>, Lake of Agios Nikolaos (stop for lunch), visit with a boat to the Blue Caves and the "Navagio" beach.

**2nd Route:** Lithakia, visit to a traditional oil press. Kiliomenos. Kambi (stop for coffee). Porto Vromi, visit by boat to the Blue Caves. Monastery of Anafonitria (stop for lunch). Volimes, stop for pictures over Alikes, visit to a winery. Bochali (stop for coffee).



#### In the plains of Zakynthos

**Rizochoria** [Root villages] took their name from their location at the foot of mount Vrachionas (Root - Riza) and represent rural Zakynthos.

At **Pantokratoras** visit the church of **Sotiras**, at **Muzaki** the church of **Agios Nikolaos** with exquisite art works, and at **Vougiato** the church of **Agios Demetrios**, which in antiquity hosted the temple of **Artemis Opitais**.

Furthermore, you can visit the church of **Yperagia Theotokos** at **Lagadakia**, as well as the **old village**, with its magnificent view to the valley, as well as the stone steeples of **Agios Georgios** and **Agios Andreas**.

At Fiolitis you can see the church of Agios Nikolaos of Schinon with the stone steeple and at Fagia the Helmi Museum of Natural History, and the

church of **Agia Marina** with its **belfry**, excellent examples of the architecture of Zakynthos.

At **Pigadakia** visit the **Vergatzio Folk Museum**, where you will get a glimpse of the rural life of the island in the 19th century.








## All roads lead to Zakynthos

A crossroads of the East and the West, Zakynthos had always been and still is a meeting place for people, populations, nations and a 'melting pot' for cultures.

You can visit it very easily, wherever you come from:

#### By road & boat

The island of Zakynthos is accessed by the northwest end of the Peloponnese, through the port of Kililini.

- The distance is 17 n.m. and the trip takes only one hour.

The ferries are modern and closed-type.

- The road trip from **Patras** to Killini takes only 45 minutes.
- If travelling from **Athens**, via the Athens
  Patras national highway, it will only take
  3.15 hours to get to Killini.
- If travelling from **Thessaloniki**, the indicated route is via the Egnatia Odos to loannina and then, to Patras via the Rio-Antirrio Bridge (which is a unique sight).

Estimated time from Thessaloniki to Killini: 6 hours.

 If travelling from Larissa, the indicated route is via Lamia - Bralos and then, to Patras via the Rio - Antirrio Bridge. Estimated time: 5.30' hours

#### By air

- Zakynthos has direct flights to Athens , with one flight a day during the winter months and two flights a day in the summer
- Zakynthos has also flights to and from all the **Ionian Islands** and **Iraclio** of Crete.
